
Ottawa, October 22nd, 1919.

Sir,

The September quarter grant of the Onion Lake C.T. boarding school is being paid on average attendance of 30 pupils and amounts to \$900.00.

Up to the present the Department has paid accounts to the amount of \$151.20 for supplies purchased from the Militia Department for your school. A deduction of \$75.00 is being made from the September quarter grant and a cheque for the balance, \$825.00, is being sent you.

The balance due for the supplies purchased from the Militia Department will be deducted from the December and March quarters.
