Reference is made to verbal request for a research of Part 11 Order entries regarding the marginally-noted soldier. An intensive search of records available do not reveal any further casualties than those shown on MFM 2(a) subsequent 14 Jun 43, attached to fly leaf of file.

2. It is pointed out that an entry should be published showing Pte Larose placed in close arrest or admitted to detention on 5 Oct 44, the day he was apprehended from desertion. Also it will be noted from the record of service, he was shown discharged from hospital and released from detention.

3. As no order can be found showing him, admitted to detention or hospital, it is suggested these casualties should be published in an After Order.

4. Regarding the suspended sentence being put back into execution, the only reference made to this, is a statement by the man himself shown at flag "A" on confidential file.

5. The "discharge with Ignominy" was certainly never remitted and he was therefore discharged under CARO 1029(9).

6. If the foregoing is not sufficient authority for your action, it is advised that the file and documents should be passed to D Adm for a ruling, please.
