Reference is made to verbal request for a research of Part 11 Order entries regarding the marginally-noted soldier. An intensive search of records available do not reveal any further casualties than those shown on MFM 2(a) subsequent 14 Jun 43, attached to fly leaf of file.

- 2. It is pointed out that an entry should be published showing Pte Larose placed in close arrest or admitted to detention on 5 Oct 44, the day he was apprehended from desertion. Also it will be noted from the record of service, he was shown discharged from hospital and released from detention.
- 3. As no order can be found showing him, admitted to detention or hospital, it is suggested these casualties should be published in an After Order.
- 4. Regarding the suspended sentence being put back into execution, the only reference made to this, is a statement by the man himself shown at flag "A" on confidential file.
- 5. The "discharge with Ignominy" was certainly never remitted and he was therefore discharged under CARO 1029(9).
- 6. If the foregoing is not sufficient authority for your action, it is advised that the file and documents should be passed to D Adm for a ruling, please.
