Sth. That the present local Reserves be surrended by the Dominion to the Brovince as soon as may be convenient; the Province agreeing to give fair compensation for any improvements or clearings made upon any Reserve which may be surrendered by the Dominion and

accepted by the Province.

EXHIBIT

The undersigned has the honour to recommend that the above suggestions be adopted, and that, if this Memorandum be approved, His Honour, the Lieutenant-Governor be respectfully requested to forward a copy thereof, and of the Minute of Council referring thereto, to the Dominion Government, for their recommendation—consideration and assent.; and he further recommends that another copy be sent to the Dominion Government for transmis sion to the Right Honourable the Secretary of State for the Colonies.
