 8th. That the present local Reserves be surrendered by
 the Dominion to the Province as soon as may be con-
 venient; the Province agreeing to give fair compen-
 sation for any improvements or clearings made upon any
 Reserve which may be surrendered by the Dominion and
 accepted by the Province.

 The undersigned has the honour to recommend that the above
 suggestions be adopted, and that, if this Memorandum be ap-
 proved, His Honour, the Lieutenant-Governor be respectfully
 requested to forward a copy thereof, and of the Minute of
 Council referring thereto, to the Dominion Government, for
 their recommendation- consideration and assent.; and he further
 recommends that another copy be sent to the Dominion Govern-
 ment for transmission to the Right Honourable the Secretary
 of State for the Colonies.
