And happy indeed will you be if, by the Word and Spirit of God, your hearts are changed and made holy, and you are thus brought into His family. He will bless you when you are young, watch over you as you grow up, enable you to serve Him wherever you are, make all things work together for your good, and, when you die, take you to be forever with Himself.

Commending you all to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you an inheritance among all them that are sanctified through faith that is in Jesus Christ.
