THE RAPIDS.

After leaving Prescott, on its way, between Drummond's Island, Tiek Island, thence to the western end of Isle aux Galops, to Lock 27 of the canal, the beginning of the great Iroquois and rapids through that canal, proceeds down the

THE RAPIDS.

These rapids, the steamers, Isle aux Galops, small islands in the Long Point—passing between Tousson's bank of the river; down the Iroquois passing which we have with rapids on each side the up steamers of the Platte Canal, from after passing Ogden's smaller ones, we pass and Chrysler's Island, between the two Cataraugus Sault—now called the rapids on the river, at Farren's Point, the canal for the up river.

THE RAPIDS.

At this rapid there, we pass Johnson's Landing, and prepare to shoot the Rapids—passing by the downstream through Cheek's Island and after steaming a short distance, we again nose between the Cornwall Island. In at Lock 15, at the end of the canal and an exit at Lock 16 of the passage
