The Reporter is housed in a building specially erected for it. The press room, business and private offices are on the first floor, with the editorial rooms, news room, job composing room and bindery on the second. In the basement are the newsboys' quarters and the news stock room. The building is heated by hot air and water. It is splendidly lighted, not less than twenty windows (excluding those in basement) being located on the river side. The equipment is in keeping with the building, and there is no job, in catalogue work especially, that cannot be undertaken by the proprietors, Messrs. J. P. and R. M. Jaffray. The plant includes seven presses, two type machines, gas engine, two paper cutters, perforators, round cornering machines, wire stitchers, etc., and the best selected stock of type to be found in any publishing house in Western Ontario.
