

THE ENGINEERS' CLUB OF TORONTO.

The fifth annual meeting of the Engineers' Club of Toronto was held in their rooms, 96 King street west, on Thursday, January 14th, the president, Mr. C. H. Rust, being in the chair. There was a large attendance of members. Following the reading of the minutes the report of the Executive Committee was presented. It showed the membership on January 12th, 1904, to have been 103 resident members and 36 non-resident members, a total of 139. Death removed one non-resident member, Mr. W. G. McN. Thompson, past president the Canadian Society of Civil Engineers, who for many years was engineer-in-charge for the Welland canal. The Executive Committee recommended that the members take greater advantage of the privileges of the reading room, and stated that the weekly luncheons had been a success.

A verbal report on behalf of the Finance Committee was given by Mr. J. A. Culverwell, who suggested that the publication of a bulletin in its present form be discontinued and the money expended in other directions with a view to increasing the interest of members in the Club. The report of the treasurer, Mr. A. C. Larkin, showed that the Club was in a good financial position, the cash assets being \$334.61. Reports were also submitted by the Library Committee and the Committee on Civic Improvements. A brief address on "The Progress of Municipal Engineering" was delivered by the president and will appear in our next issue.

Three new members were elected, after which the officers for 1904 were chosen. It was the unanimous wish of the Club that Mr. Willis Chipman, the present secretary, should occupy the president's chair during the year, but Mr. Chipman very modestly declined the honor. The following officers were then elected: President, Capt. Gamble; first vice-president, Mr. R. F. Tate; second vice-president, Mr. James McDougall; secretary, Mr. Willis Chipman; treasurer, Mr. A. C. Larkin; directors, Messrs. J. Sing, A. J. Van Nostrand and W. H. Patton. The annual auction sale of periodicals concluded the business of the meeting.

The past-presidents of the Club are: Messrs. Kivas Tulley, 1899-1900; A. L. Hertzberg, 1901; Major Henry A. Gray, 1902; C. H. Rust, 1903.

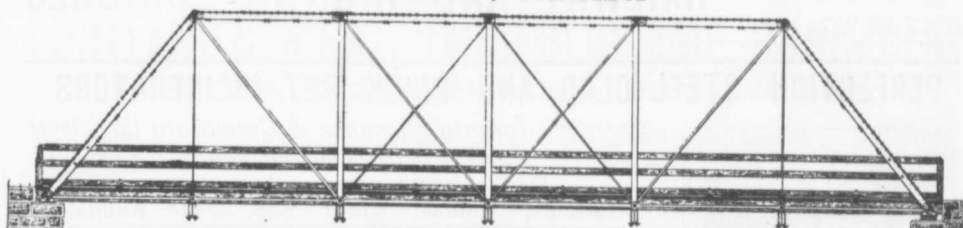
