Gamble; first vice-president, Mr. R. F. Tate; second vice-president, Mr. James McDougall; secretary, Mr. Willis Chipman; treasurer, Mr. A. C. Larkin; directors, Messrs. J. Sing, A. J. Van Nostrand and W. H. Patton. The annual auction sale of periodicals concluded the business of the meeting.


