the Province for the time being, to appoint three Commissionners who shall be and they are hereby authorized to Contract and agree with any persons willing to settle themselves in the manner herein above prescribed, on the said road (the rights of the Seigniors of land on which such settlements are to be made being always observed) relatively to the intended settlements, and to name Experts to visit such settlements and report whether the conditions and requirements of this Act have been complied with so as to entitle such settlers or any and which of them to the benefits thereof, nor shall any payment be made to any such settler until the report of the Experts shall have been approved by a majority of the Commissioners.
