An engrossed Bill to appoint Commissioners to borrow Thirty Thousand Pounds on the part of the Province, was read a third time.

Resolved, That the Bill do pass, and that the Title be. An Act to appoint Commissioners to Borrow Twenty Thousand Pounds on the part of the Province; and to authorise the Issuing of Treatury Notes.

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Council, and defire their concurrence to the fame.

An Engrossed Bill for granting to His Majesty an additional Revenue to defray the expense of the War, was read a third time.

On motion, the House resolved itself into a Committee of the whole House, to consider further of a Supply.
