A Bill to amend certain Acts respecting the College of *Regiopolis*, and to confer the powers and privileges of an University on the same, was, according to Order, read the third time.

Resolved, That the Bill do pass; and the title be, "An Act to amend the Acts respecting the College of *Regiopolis*, and to erect the same into an University."

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

A Bill to incorporate the *Canada Vine-Growers' Association*, was, according to Order, read the third time.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. *Galt*, seconded by Mr. *Walsh*, the Bill was amended, by adding the following words at the end of the second clause: "subject to such conditions and regulations as may, from time to time, be ordered by the Governor in Council."

Resolved, That the Bill do pass; and the title be, "An Act for the incorporation of "the *Canada Vine-Growers' Association*."

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

A Bill to amend the Act 25 *Vic.*, Cap. 30, to enable the Rate-payers of the County of *Lincoln* to select a more convenient place for their County Town, was, according to Order, read the third time.

Resolved, That the Bill do pass.

Ordered, That the Clerk do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

A Bill to confirm and establish the existing line between the 4th and 5th Ranges of the Township of *Buckingham*, was, according to Order, read the third time.
