According to the Gazette, the ranchers in the Grand Forks valley shipped this year 65 carloads of fruit, 1400 tons of potatoes and over 20,000 bushels of wheat. The output was valued at \$150,000. Some of the potatoes were sold at \$21.50 a ton.

Some 1500 acres in the Elk river valley, near Herald, have just been surveyed and will be set apart for the returned soldiers who may care to go on the land in that section of British Columbia.

The Vernon News states that Okanagan growers will receive 40 per cent better prices for apples and crabapples this year, as compared with 1917 and on soft fruits the increased price is from 10 to 25 per cent.


