#### All Canadians Are Forest Owners

Canada is in a unique position in regard to forests. Not only has she still large forest resources, but about 95 per cent of the land on which these forests stand belongs to the Dominion or to the people of Canada. from the lumberman a price per thousand feet when the timber is cut and a ground rental for every year the lumberman occupies the land. Thus, in addition to the benefit Canada receives from timber as a great basis of trade and manufacture, the basis of trade and manufacture, the taxes are reduced by the amount of this revenue. It therefore doubly be hoves every Canadlan to do all in his power to stop forest fires. Tour lets may start a fire by throwing a lighted match from a smoking car, or a clearing fire may get away from a settler clearing his land, or a hunter or fisherman may leave his camp ter or fisherman may leave his camp fre still burning when he breaks camp. Everyone should remember that every time these things happen and a fire starts every citizen in Can ada is a loser. Those who care to pursue this subject further may secure free of charge a bulletin giving the statistics of forest fires by applying to the Director of Forestry, Ottowe

Utilize Canada's Rescurces Canadians are justly proud of their structural timbers—red pine, western soft pine, tamarack, hemlock, Douglas fir, etc. That the qualities of these timbers may be well known to Can-adian builders, so that the importation of no better or even inferior timbers may be reduced the Forestry Branch of the Department of the Interior has issued a publication known as Bulletin No. 59, "Canadian Woods for Structural Timbers," giving the facts about these woods. This has been followed by Bulletin No. 60, been followed by Bulletin No. 60, "Douglas Fir: Its Mechanical and Physical Properties," which deals with wood from every point which is of interest to the structura! engineer and builder. Those interested may secure these bulletins free upon application to the Director of Forestry, Ottawa.

eading is naturally that of making the prairies look more like home to people who have come from Eastern Canada and from other countries where there are many trees and soc iable things and give an air of com-fort to the landscape. More than that, in proper places, as along the borders of fields, trees are of great benefit to dwellers on the prairie. They form a wind-break against cold winds in the winter and against hot drying winds in summer, they prevent snow drifting deep about barns and outbuildings, and, as the windbreak and shelter-belt get older the thinnings come in handy for posts and rails, and even for fuel. it used to be thought that trees would not grow on the prairie, but since over fifty million tree seedlings and cuttings have been sent out to prairie farms by the Superintendent of the Dominion Forest Nursery Station at Indian Head and since at the request of western farmers about five million more of these free trees are now go ing out every spring, it is evident that old idea is now thoroughly exploded. It is harder to grow trees on the prairie than in the formerly timbered country of Eastern Canada, but the methods which must be followed are now known and have been embodied in bulletins which may be secured free upon application to the Superintendent Forest Nursery Sta-tion, Indian Head, Saskatchewan.
