

## FINANCIAL AND COMMERCIAL

EGGS WERE PLENTIFUL  
ON MARKET TODAY

Twenty Cents a Dozen the Ruling Price—Apples Continue Very Scarce.

This morning's market was again a small one with few features. Business was fairly brisk in most lines, although oats came down a notch, selling from \$1.32 to \$1.42. One load sold yesterday afternoon at \$1.50 per cwt.

A load of wheat brought \$1.05 per bushel, while a small quantity of seed peas sold for 50 cents a bushel. Hay quotations were practically unchanged.

Eggs were plentiful at 20 cents a dozen on the open square. The market was practically deserted at 11 o'clock, however. Butter in rolls sold at 27 cents a pound.

The prices for live hogs for Monday have not as yet been stated, but will probably be \$6.75 per cwt.

Apples continue very scarce, a barrel of Baldwins selling at \$4 this morning.

Maple syrup was quoted at \$1.25 a gallon.
