Newcastle, N. B., July 6-W. M. Sullivan's mill at Red Bank caught fire Monday afternoon between three and four o'clock, and was soon in flames. four o'cloch, and was soon in flames. Aid was sought from Newcastle, and about four o'clock a contingent of firemen with fire engine left here on steamer Dorothy N. Sullivan's tug boat met her near here. The engine was on a scow; it arrived at 6.30, too late to save the mill, but helped to save the houses near. The mill was totally destroyed; also the wharf and deal piles. The store and residence were piles. The store and residence were saved with difficulty.

Flames crossed the river and des-troyed Charles Mullin's barn. About fifty men are out of work. It was Red Bank's principal industry. The insurance was at least \$10,000; the loss must be \$40,000.






