THE RUN OF LIVE STOCK WAS LIGHT, 30 loads all told, composed of 421 cattle, 1640 hogs, 230 sheep, and 2000 chickens.

The quality of live cattle generally was fair, but there were too many of the lower grades of butchers' stock.

Owing to the uncertainty of space the best, capcoters were not in good demand.

Trade was much the same as on Friday previous. Demand for the quantities of that date, a given in the following table.
