## PARISH NOTES.

A SPLENDID GIFT.—Mrs. Gosling presented to the Church on Easter Eve a communicants' kneeling cushion of crimson, adorned with white lilies, beautifully embroidered—her own work, executed at intervals during the past two years.

An old banner belonging to the Sunday School has been found in an attic in the rectory where it has lain packed away no one knows how long. This was used on Easter Sunday, together with the handsome one made at the time of the Sunday School Centennial, at which time also the Phœbe Street Sunday School displayed their banner, the workmanship of Miss Wood and Miss Mitchell.
