SECRET

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter No. E-78 of June 1951, which is worded as follows:

(See Note I)

"In March, 1950, ...
where inauguration of such programme is being considered ...
That letter sets forth accurately the terms of the agreement concluded
between the representatives of our two Governments with regard to the above.
On behalf of the French Government, I have the honour to inform you that I
have that letter and this reply as constituting an agreement between our
two Governments, both texts being authentic.

Accept, Sir, the assurances of my highest consideration.
