EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to your Note No. 60/73 of June 7, 1973, proposing that the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany concerning the use of the Churchill Research Range, which was signed at Ottawa on July 8, 1969<sup>(1)</sup>, and amended by an Exchange of Notes dated April 28, 1972<sup>(2)</sup>, should be extended until June 30, 1975.

I am pleased to inform you that the Government of Canada accepts the proposals set forth in your Note and agrees that your Note, together with this reply which is authentic in English and French, shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on July 1, 1973, and remain in effect until June 30, 1975.

It is understood that these arrangements shall also apply to Land Berlin, provided that the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany does not make a contrary declaration to the Government of Canada within three months of the entry into force of this agreement.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurance of my highest consideration.
