

The GATT provides that affected countries may withdraw equivalent concessions or request offsetting compensation as an alternative. The President and the Prime Minister announced that the slate will be wiped clean with respect to compensation rights for those actions no longer in effect.

- Easing of Certain U.S. Restrictions on the Imports of Certain Sugar-Containing Products: The President undertook today best efforts to exempt certain sugar-containing products from restrictions imposed under Section 22 of the Agricultural Adjustment Act.
- Copyright: Cable/Satellite Retransmission: The Prime Minister informed the President that it is the Government's intention to meet the challenge of creating an appropriate and balanced copyright environment. To this end, the Minister of Communications has recently referred proposed revisions to Canada's Copyright Act to the Parliamentary Committee on Communications and Culture for consideration. The Prime Minister assured the President that revision of the Act is a priority. The Prime Minister undertook best efforts to accommodate U.S. concerns on the protection of programming retransmitted by cable or satellite when the Government develops legislative proposals.
