Excellency,


I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America for the Establishment of a Binational Educational Exchange Foundation, done at Ottawa on February 13, 1990.⁽¹⁾ Further to the discussions which have recently taken place between representatives of our two Governments, I have the honour to propose that paragraph 2 of Article V of that Agreement be replaced by the following:

" 2. The Foundation shall be governed by a Board consisting of twenty members, ten of whom will be citizens or nationals of the United States of America and ten of whom will be citizens or nationals of Canada. "

and that, in paragraph 5 of the same Article, "the other seven American members" and "the other seven Canadian members" be replaced by "the other nine American members" and "the other nine Canadian members" respectively.

I have the honour to propose that, if the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of the United States of America, this Note, which is equally authentic in English and French, and your reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.

Accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.
