CONFEDERATION ESSAYS. The National Committee for the Celebration of the Diamond Jubilee of Confederation has presented to McGill University three medals, in gold, silver and bronze, to be awarded as prizes for essays on Confederation. Those eligible as competitors are undergraduates and graduates proceeding to the Masters Degrees during the present session. Essays must be addressed to the Registrar and must be received on or before April 50th. The sward will be announced at the May Convocation. Essays must deal with any of the following three subjects:-(a) Canada's contribution to political progress (b) Ganada's contribution to scientific progress (e) Canada's contribution to economic progress.
