Cape Breton, the open season for all birds (excepting partridge) is from August 20th to February 28th.

Pheasant, blackcock, capercailzie, sharp-tailed grouse, spruce partridge, protected at all times.

NON-RESIDENTS' LICENSE

Non-residents are required to obtain licenses from the Provincial Secretary to shoot—Big game, \$30; birds and rabbits, \$10.

FISH,—Trout of all kinds and land-locked salmon. April 2nd to September 30th.

Salmon, from February 2nd to August 14th, by fly fishing.

FISHING LICENSES

Non-residents are required to obtain licenses to fish, which may be obtained on application to the Provincial Secretary.

PROVINCE OF MANITOBA

(OPEN SEASON)

GAME.—All kinds of deer, including antelope, cabri, ek, or wapiti, moose, reindeer, or caribon, or their fawns, between October 16th and December 14th; no one person may kill or take more than two of the said animals. This does not apply to deer which are private property and taken on his own lands and premises by or with the consent of the owner.

Otter, fisher, or pekan and sable, from October 2nd to May 14th.

Muskrat, from December 2nd to April 30th.

Marten, from November 2nd to April 14th.

Beaver, perpetually protected

GAME BIRDS.-All varieties of grouse, including prairie chicken, pheasant and partridges, between October 2nd and November 14th, and it is illegal for one person to kill more than 100 in one year or more than 20 in one day.

Woodcock, plover, snipe and sandpipers, between August 2nd and December 31st.

All kinds of wild duck, see duck, widgeon, teal, between September 2nd and April 30th.

Upland plover, from July 16th to December 31st. Sunday shooting is entirely prohibited.

NON-RESIDENTS' LICENSES

Non-residents of the Province must secure a hunting license from the Minister of Agriculture at Winnipeg, fee \$50, for the calendar year.

Fish.—Whitefish, tullibee, salmon or lake troot, from December 16th to October 4th.

Pickerel (dore), from May 16th to April 14th.

Sturgeon, from June 16th to May 14th.

Speckled trout, from January 1st to September 30th.

THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES

(OPEN SEASON)

Big Game.—Elk, moose, caribou, antelope, deer, October 2nd to January 31st. (It is forbidden to take more than 6 head in any one season.)

Mountain sheep or goat, October 2nd to January 31st. (1t is forbidden to take more than 6 head in any one season.)

Mink, fisher or marten, November 2nd to April 14th.
