## NOTES OF THE MONTH.

September signifies the seventh, from the Latin Septem, although it is the ninth month of our year. It was dedicated by the Romans to Vulcan. The ending of the name, ember or imber, the Latin for shower, indicates that the wet season has set in. Libra, the balance, is entered by the sun on the 23d, and is typical of the day and night then being equal. The full moon nearest this day is the harvest moon. The 21st is St. Matthew's, and the 29th, Michaelmas Day, is the third quarter of the year.
