Those in business all the year round carry the business on during the slack season and the others reap the profit of the good part of the year. It was said that in other cities extra fees were charged such taxi men who operated only part of the year.

The mayor said he appreciated the force of the arguments used and would communicate with other cities to see how such matters were conducted elsewhere. When the necessary information is received a meeting of all those interested will be called.


