### STRANGE TALE TOLD IN POLICE COURT

Woman with Two Husbands Charges No. 1, Missing Twenty Years, with Non-Support.

Ottawa, July 10.—After being separated for twenty years from her husband, during which time she was again married, Mrs. Damithello Chartand, St. Patrick street, appeared in police court before Magistrate Askwith, charging her first husband, Evariste Chartand, 82 Pine street, with non-support.

According to the story told by Mrs. Chartand, she married Chartand when she was 14 years of age, and when he was 39 years of age. He left her twenty years ago, and for five years she heard nothing of him. She married again, thinking her first husband dead, and has a boy who is now 15 years old by her second husband. Her second husband left her and she met her first husband again and wants him to support her, claiming that he spoiled her and that she was young for marriage when they were united.

Magistrate Askwith dismissed the case on account of the evidence given.
