PREFACE.

The Editor begs leave to present the Tenth Volume of the Dominion Swine Breeders' Record. In this volume the names of the breeders of the sire and grand-sire, as well as the dam, appear; and the pedigrees are abbreviated to the first dam, keeping each breed separate, with separate pages and indexes, so that the different breeds can be bound together, if found necessary.

There are still several certificates missing, recorded in 1894 which have not been sent in to be copied since the fire, consequently they do not appear in this volume.

This volume contains 1,313 Berkshires, 1,175 Yorkshires, 350 Chester Whites, 166 Poland Chinas, 709 Tamworths, 88 Duroc-Jerseys, 37 Suffolks, 14 Victorias, 29 Essex, or a total of 3,881 pedigrees.
