Extract from a Report of the Committee of the Afonourable the Privy Council, approved by Ais Excellency on the 26th November, 1894.

On a memorandum dated 19th November 1894, from the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs, stating that in order to arrive at a satisfactory settlement of a dispute which has arisen respecting the ownership of a parcel of land in the Indian Reserve at Caughnawaga, it will be necessary to hold an enquiry under oath; and recommending that Mr Alexander Brosseau, Indian Agent for the Iroquois Band of Caughnawaga, be authorized under section 2, Chapter 33, 50-51 Vic., to summon persons before him by subpoena, to examine such persons under oath, and to compel the production of papers and writings in respect of the said dispute.

The Committee submit the above recommendation for Your Excellency's approval.
