"Sec. 32. The assessors shall ascer-tain as nearly as possible the particu-ars of the real estate, the personal property, and the income of any per-son, who has not brought in a stat-ment in accordance with their notice and as required by this law, and shall make an estimate thereof at the true value and amount, to the best of their information and belief; and such esti-mate shall be conclusive upon all per-sons who have not filed their state-ments in due time, unless they can show a reasonable excuse for the omission." "Sec. 42. No person shall have an abatement unless he has filed with the assessors the statement under oath within the time required; nor shall the Common Council, in any case, sus-statin an appeal from the judgment of the assessors, unless they shall be satisfied that there was good cause why the statement was not filed in due time as herein provided."
