North Shore Ports Preprpe for Rush of Business — Many Men will be Employed — Chatham News.

Chatham, N. B., May 13.—The opening of navigation on the Miramichi means a very big thing to the industrial life of the community, for when the mills get running and the average number of ships are lowered to the old country, employment is given to 2,500 workmen.

Down River Mills. The Rundele mill at Hartbouge is all ready and will probably start today. Employs about 50 to 60 men.

In Chatham. The big Snowball mill is all ready for a start, but is being held back by the lack of logs.

Up River Mills. The Snowball mill at Millerton is also being put in shape for the season's work and will employ about 100 men.

Newcastle Mills. The Hickox mill and the T. Ritchie mill at Newcastle each employ about 100 workmen, and the probability is that they will be running this week.
