### **New Armistice** Terms Drastic

London, Jan. 15 .- (British Wire less Service)—The new armistic terms to be presented to Germany by Marshal Foch are unofficially stated here to include the follow

stated here to include the following:

First—Retribution on the Germans for the murder and ill-treatment of Allied prisoners.

Second — The machinery and goods stolen by Germany from France and Belgium to be at once given up. It is pointed out that France alone has 500,000 men who will be out of work until this machinery is returned.

Third—German gold, amounting to more than 100,000,000 pounds to be moved from Berlin to a safe place, probably Frankfort, and protected from Bolshevism in Germany en route. Certain other property to be surrendered.

Fourth—Germany to give over her shipping, of which she is believed to have 4,000,000 tons, to carry food supplies to countries in Europe in need of them.

Fifth—Any U-boats on the stocks to be handed to the Allies for their disposal or to be destroyed, and no more submarines to be built.
