Mr. Morgan demanded a recount, which was made before Judge Lyon, and the votes polled in three subdivisions rejected as being marked so as to identify voters. This gave Mr. Morgan a majority of 27, and he was declared elected. Subsequently Mr. Baker appealed to the courts and Chief Justice and V.-C. Blake decided that the Dep. Retg. Officers had placed the marks (i.e., figures) on the ballots by mistake, and, under the Act, the votes were not voided. Therefore they declared Mr. Baker elected.
