or collegiate, or communities and all persons whatsoever. so conveying as aforesaid, are hereby indemnified for what he, she, or they, or any of them, shall respectively do by virtue of or in pursuance of this Act.

VIII. Provided always, and be it enacted, That any 5 rent in certain body politic, community, corporation, or other person or persons whomsoever, who cannot in common course of law sell or alienate any lands or grounds so required by the said Company for the purposes of this Act, shall agree upon a fixed annual rent as an equivalent, and not upon a 10 principal sum, to be paid for the lands or grounds so required by the said Company for the purposes of this Act; and in case the amount of such rent shall not be fixed by voluntary agreement or compromise, it shall be fixed in the manner hereinafter prescribed, and all proceedings 15 shall in that case be regulated as hereinafter prescribed; and for the payment of the said annual rent, and every other annual rent agreed upon or ascertained and to be paid by the said Company for the purchase of any lands, or for any part of the purchase money of any land which 20 the vendor shall agree to leave in the hands of the said Company, the said Railroad and the tolls to be levied and collected thereon shall be, and are hereby made liable and chargeable, in preference to all other claims or demands thereon whatsoever, the deed creating such 25 charge and liability being duly registered.

IX. Provided always, and be it enacted, That whenever there shall be more than one party proprietor of any land or property *par indivis*, any agreement made in faith between the said Company and any party or parties pro- 30 prietor, or being together proprietors of one-third or more of such land or property, as to the amount of compensation for the same or for any damages thereto, shall be binding as between the remaining proprietor or proprietors par invidis and the Company, and the proprietor or 35 proprietors who have so agreed may deliver possession of such land or property to the Company, or empower them to enter upon the same, as the case may be.

And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the owners of pro- said Company to apply to the several owners of, or par- 40 ties hereby empowered to convey the lands through which such Railroad is intended to be carried, or which may suffer damage from the making of the said Railroad, or the exercise of any of the powers granted to the said Company by this Act; and to agree with such owners or 45 parties respectively, touching the compensation to be paid to them by the said Company for the purchase thereof, and for the respective damages, and to make such agreements and contracts with the said parties touching the said lands or the compensation to be paid for the same, 50 or for the damages, or as to the mode in which the said
