## BILL.

An Act to impose duties on Hawkers, Pedlars and Petty Chapmen, and on Persons keeping Billiard Tables for profit, and to provide for the collection of the said Duties.

WHEREAS, by an Act passed during the Preamble. present Session it is enacted, that the several Acts imposing duties on Hawkers, Pedlars, and other itinerant Traders, and on persons keeping Billiard Tables for profit, and providing for the collection of such duties, shall be repealed from and after the

day of in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and , to the end that the provisions of law relative to the matters aforesaid may be amended, consolidated and made uniform throughout the Province, and it is expedient to make legislative provision accordingly; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the No person to same, That (except as hereinafter excepted) act as a Haw-ker and Pedlar no person other than a person licensed in the without a Li-manner hereinafter mentioned as a Hawker cense. and Pedlar, shall act as such within this Province under a penalty of currency, for each offence or act done in contravention to this section; and every tra- who shall be velling Petty Chapman or itinerant Trader, deemed Hawkers and Pedor person who shall travel with goods, wares, lars. or merchandize, for the purpose of trade or barter, from place to place, or to other men's houses, or who shall act as a trader without having a permanent residence in some town or place within the Province, shall be deemed to be a Hawker and Pedlar within the meaning of this Act, and for all the purposes there-of; Provided always, that any person or party parties licenhaving at the time when this Act shall come sed before this into force, a License to act as a Hawker and Act is in force.
