

sixty dollars, immediately after the Second Reading thereof; and all such Bills shall be prepared in the English and French languages, by the parties applying for the same, and printed by the Contractor for printing the Bills of the House, and 350 copies thereof in English shall be deposited in the Private Bill Office, with 200 copies in French also of such Bills as relate to Lower Canada, before the Second Reading; and no such Bill shall be read a Third time until a certificate from the Queen's Printer shall have been filed with the Clerk, that the cost of printing 500 copies of the Act in English and 250 in French, for the Government, has been paid to him. 10—The Fee payable on the Second Reading of any Private Bill, shall be paid only in the House in which such Bill originates, but the cost of printing the same shall be paid in each House. (L. C. 49.) (L. A. 59.)
