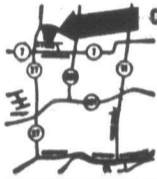

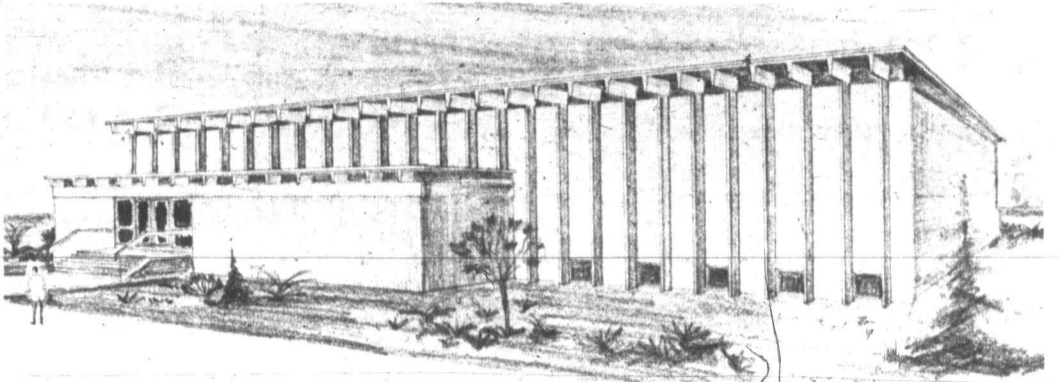

**New Legion centre for Malton Branch**

Malton Legionnaires are looking forward to a new, modern building designed to accommodate the branch's every need.

Al James, president of Malton Branch 528 of the Royal Canadian Legion, announced plans for a handsome, new 12,000 square-foot building adjacent to the present hall on Derry rd.

The ground floor of the air-conditioned, concrete and brick structure will feature a spacious game room, men's and ladies' lounges, a TV lounge, committee rooms and a food-preparation centre.

The main floor entrance lobby with offices and cloakrooms nearby, will lead to a large auditorium suited for dances, banquets and meetings.

At one end, above a good dispensary, a mezzanine lounge will over-

look the auditorium and stage.

The grounds will be appropriately landscaped, with ample provision for parking. Also proposed, if sufficient interest is shown by the community, is a cenotaph dedicated to

the war dead, which would be incorporated into the front facade or stand in front of the building.

Mr. James reports that engineering site-investigations have been completed and that design de-

tails are now being finalized. Construction is expected to begin shortly.

The need for larger facilities, according to Mr. James, arises from a rapid growth in membership and anticipation of even larger growth.

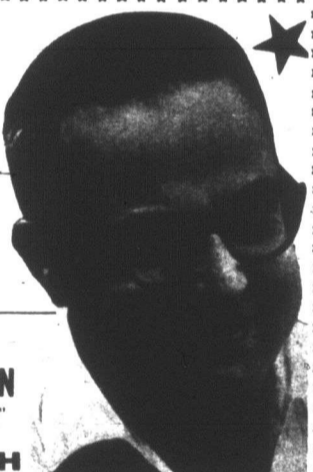
