pany has applied for 1.60 acres required to divert the regular road allowance so as to cross at the end of their station grounds. The road diversion appears to be desirable as the crossing will now only cross the one track instead of crossing also their siding. Agent Nichol has valued these lands at \$20.per acre, a total of \$2.00, which appears to be a fair and just valuation. I beg to recommend that the Railway Company be asked to pay this sum as damages and to construct the road. It is not intended that they should be given a patent for these lands but that the road should remain in the possession of this Department.
