I have not yet received the same though I find that on the manifest on S. Scamosun they had some fittings on a board which were not delivered.

This delay is very annoying as we are absolutely out of water. Kindly take this matter up with the Union S. 300 and see what the matter is.

The Camosun sails again on Thursday evening, from Vancouver.
