of Capital and Labor through industrial parliaments or similar bodies. The two ideas are at once similar and antagonistic. Each dwells on the need for an increasing share in control for Labor; but the one bases its policy on the idea of a fundamental antagonism between Capital and Labor, and the other on that of an essential community of interest.
