

Sir,

With reference to letter to you^r of the 1st June last and your reply of the 7th of that month, as well as subsequent correspondence, in respect to the application made by ~~the~~ Mr Agent Wheatley, on behalf of the young man Joseph Paul for a team of horses to enable him to start farming on his own account, I beg to transmit herewith for your information and report thereon copy of a letter of the 28th ultimo, from Mr Wheatley in the matter, in which he renews his application. You will note that the Department sanctioned the purchase of a yoke of oxen for Paul, but arrangements were afterwards made to give the oxen to Geo. Hunter, who at the time was considered to be more in need of the animals.
