



Sir:-

I beg to enclose herewith for your information and report thereon, copy of a letter of the 31st ultimo which the Department has received from Jerry Lane Cloud who lives in Dartmouth. You will observe that he states that he is living in a poor camp, and that he and his family are destitute, and also that he is both ill and blind. It is desired that you will immediately enquire into the facts of this case. When reporting, you should make such recommendation as you deem advisable. If the family are in pressing need, you may furnish a small amount of relief when you visit them, but the facts should be laid before the Department.
