
Reverend Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th instant, in which you state that you are forwarding a new application for the admission of James McDonald to the Ermineskins Boarding School.

In reply I beg to say that as you have already been informed, this boy is a protestant and his admission to your school cannot therefore be approved.

As you were informed by official letter of the 18th ultimo the Department will not knowingly admit any Roman Catholic child to a protestant school or any protestant child to a Roman Catholic school.
