The Minister of Finance and Receiver General of Canada is hereby authorized and required, and of such moneys as are in, or shall come to his hands; for defraying the expenses of the Civil Government of Canada to pay

the sum of \$91,978,194.24

in a special account to be called

"Expenses for maintenance of essential public services"

out of which advances shall be made from time to time as required by the issue of cheques in the usual course, in accordance with the provisions of Section 25 of Chapter 27, 21-22 George V, - no appropriation being available and the necessity therefor urgent.

And for the Minister of Finance and Receiver General of Canada so doing, this Warrant shall be to him a sufficient discharge.
