

"SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE"

1. Deserting His Majesty's Service.

E 134794, Corporal W.E.H. Mattocks, No. 100 Canadian Army Basic Training Centre, C.A. having been duly sworn states:

' I was an instructional N.C.O. in No. 3 platoon of No. 1 Coy, on the 21st of June 1943. I recognize the accused No. H 615595 Pte. Mike Dudeck and he was in my platoon at this date.

At 0530 hours on the 21st of June 1943, I called the platoon roll call, in the quarters at No. 100 Canadian Army (Basic) Training Centre, C.A., Portage la Prairie, Manitoba. Private Dudeck failed to answer his name. I checked his bed and found it had not been slept in. I marked him as absent without leave on the platoon parade state.

I called the roll for that platoon until it left on draft and the accused was not present at any time. He has been A.W.L. since then until he returned.
