

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE
THE
BRITISH AMERICAN
MANUFACTURING COMPANY.

[Assented to 19th May, 1860.]

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**W**HEREAS Ashley Hibbard, John R. Ford, Preamble.  
James Bishop and Christopher Meyer,  
have petitioned for the incorporation of themselves  
and others as the British American Manufactur-  
ing Company, for the Manufacture of Cotton  
and other goods, and it is expedient to grant their  
Petition: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with  
the advice and consent of the Legislative Coun-  
cil and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The aforesaid persons and all others who shall become Shareholders in the said Company, and incorporate shall be and are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of *The British American Manufacturing Company*.

2. The Company may carry on the business of manufacturing goods and fabrics of all descriptions, that are capable of being produced from Cotton, as also such other goods of other
