ARTICLE I.

MEMBERSHIP.

(a) A proposition for membership shall only be received at the hand of a member, and shall be referred to a committee on Character, to be appointed by the chair.

(b) The committee on Character shall report on the proposition at the ensuing regular meeting and if the report be favourable, a vote shall be taken and if two-thirds of the members are in favour, the candidate shall be declared elected by the chairman.
