BACK TO OUR OLD LAW. LORD'S DAY ACT OF ONTARIO ULTRA VIRES.

Decision of Privy, Council in England-Sunday Now Protected by Act of Upper Canada Passed in 1845-Review of the Case.

Toronto, July 15. - A scable gram was received at the Attorney-General's office yesterday announcing that the Imperial Privy Council had declared the Ontario Lord's Day act ultra vires of the Provincial Legislature. The news came somewhat as a shock to the repre-sentatives of the Lord's Day Alliance, which body has been seeking to have it declared that the act applies to corporations incorporated by Domcorporations incorporated by Dominion legislation, and which carried the case to the Privy Council on this latter point, not expecting the above result. A cablegram received at the office of the Alliance explained that the ground of the decision was the same as had been taken by the late Judge Armour, who as Chief Justice of Ontario had held that as the act dealt with religious matters, infractions of it were criminal, and came within the exclusive jurisdiction given the Dominion Government by the British North America act. The cablegram stated that the general question of Provincial jurisdiction was still open.
