

ENTRY.

Entry may be made personally at the local land office for the District in which the land to be taken in situate, or if the homesteader dustres he may, on application to the Minister of the function Unitawa, the Commissioner of the district in which the land is situate, receive authority for some one to make entry for him. authority for some one to make entry for A fee of \$10 is charged for a homestead

#### HOMESTEAD DUTIES.

A settler who has been granted an entry for a homestead is required by the provisions of the Dominion Lands Act and the amendments thereto to perform the conditions connected herewith, under one of the following plans:-

At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years.

(2) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) or any person who is cligible to make a homestead entry mon the provisions of this Act, resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for by such person as a home-staal, the requirements of this Act as to re-sidence prior to obtaining pattern may be satisfied by such person residing with the father or mother.

(3) If a settler has obtained a patent for his homestead, or a certificate for the issue of such patent countersigned in themanner pre-scribed by this Act, and has obtained entry for a second homestead, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the first homestead, if the second homestead is in the vicinity of the first homestead.

(4) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his household, the requirements of this Act as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

The term "vicinity" used above is meant o indicate the same township or an adjoining or cornering township.

A settler who avails himself of the provisions of Clauses (2) (3) or (4) must cultivate 30 acres of his homestead, or substitute 50 head of stock, with buildings for their accommodation, and have besides 80 acres substantially fenced.

Every homesteader who fails to comply with the requirements of the homesteader law is able to have his entry cancelled, and the land ay be again thrown open for entry.
